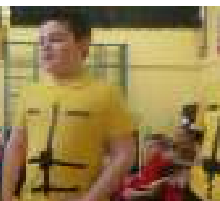
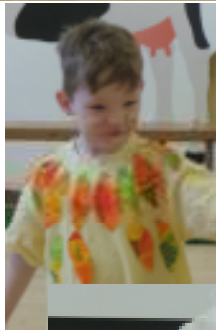
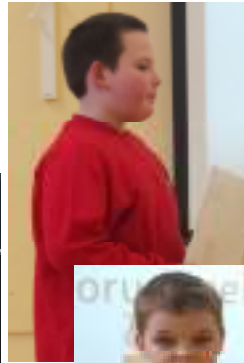
Disco tickets are still available from the School Office at £1.00 per person.
