Dear Parents and Carers,

Can I please remind you of the following.

It is really important that you keep the school informed and up to date with your correct contact details in case we need to contact you in an emergency. If you change your phone number or address please inform the office immediately.

If your child is off sick please ring the office before 9.00am to let us know your child will not be attending that day. Please also contact your child's transport provider.

If your child has sickness or diarrhoea they **MUST** be kept off school for 48 hours after the last episode. It is very important you do not allow your child to come back before this time because even though they may appear to be better, they can still be carrying the virus which can cause other children and staff to become unwell.
