Literacy



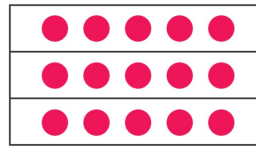
In Literacy we have continued

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In Topic this week we have been learning about the history of chocolate. We learnt when cacao beans were first found in Mexico through to Cadburys releasing their first box of chocolates!

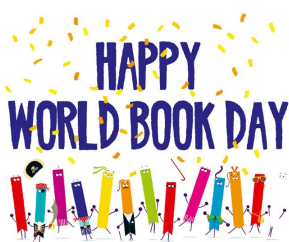
