Class 4!

In Class 4 this week during our topic we have been developing our use of language through looking at words to describe the sound food makes when we eat it. E.g. 'crunch' 'munch' 'crackle'. We have also had our very own lemonade stand which the children have enjoyed being in charge of.

In Phonics, some of our children have been looking at the 'ch' sound, matching pictures to the correct word. Others have been looking at 't' sound. We have been looking at letter formation and spelling words with the letters 's' 'a' 't'.













In my Outdoor School this week Class 4 have been finding natural objects such as sticks, leaves, grass for our sensory play the next morning. We gave full ownership to the children, and they really thrived from this, knowing what they collected would be there to search through the following day.

In Play and Leisure this week the children have been looking at different ways to build. The children have had access to big wooden buildings and Lego which they have gained valuable social skills from, working with peers.
