Literacy

Class 10

In Literacy, we have read the next chapter of 'The Snow Queen'. Some children have written a letter from Gerda to her grandmother and have included the main features of letter writing. Others have used colourful semantics to construct a simple letter. In addition, the children have used their phonics skills to label animals from the story and write simple sentences to describe their physical features.

In Storytime, the children have listened to 'Amazing Grace' by Mary Hoffman.

Numeracy

In Numeracy, the children have continued to develop their understanding of Place Value. They have calculated how many tens and ones there are in a two-digit number using the ten frames and dienes. Some children have started a new topic: Length and Height. They have used a ruler to measure a selection of objects in centimetres.



PSHE

In PSHE, the children have continued to explore our new topic: Healthy Me. They have been learning about the dangers of taking recreational drugs and the damaging effects they can have on peoples minds and bodies. The children have discussed their feelings towards drugs and how they could stay safe.

Topic

This week, the children have continued to enjoy our topic: Buildings. They have been learning about new houses and how they are built. The children have watched a video showing how bricks are made. They looked carefully at the staggered pattern when laying bricks and enjoyed making a brick wall out of clay.
