In Numeracy this week the children have been learning to use the language of solve number stories.






In literacy, we have continued to explore our story of 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff.' The children enjoyed sequencing the story and performing a retell, using role-play.







In Topic we continued to build on our knowledge of the story 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff', but with a D&T focus. The children thought carefully about the bridge in the story before exploring photos of different types of bridges. They then designed , built and tested their own bridge to find what materials made the strongest and weakest bridge.















In Science the children explored 'Everyday materials' to help develop their growing knowledge of objects and the material they are made from. They collected items from inside and outside the classroom, before identifying and grouping correctly. This then helped their building skills and material choices when building their bridges in D&T.







Finally, in Music the children enjoyed working with Emily. Enthusiastically, they followed actions and moved to the beat of the music. They used clapping, stomping, waving and dancing to represent a fast and slow rhythm.
