This week we have been focusing on our targets which were agreed during the children's Annual Reviews.

In Numeracy we have been ordering numbers to 10, finding 1 more and 1 less from a set number and practising our shapes!

In Literacy we have moved onto the book 'Supertato Eviltato vs Superpea'. The children engaged with this book really well and came up with some great descriptive words for the characters. We have used Colourful Semantics with new vocabulary for the Class to explore.

We have had a lovely week, and the Children have enjoyed being outside in the warmer weather completing various activities with chalk on the playground.
