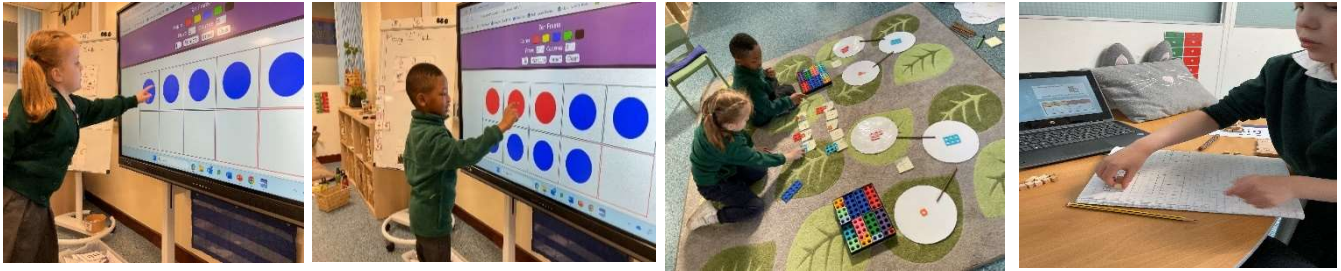

Hello and welcome to another week from the Hub! It has been another fabulous week with lots of learning, fun and laughter- all in the beautiful Spring Sun!

This week in Numeracy, we have been developing our understanding of addition. We have used practical resource, ten frames and part whole diagrams to help us find a total. Some children worked with numbers to 10/ 20, while others worked with numbers to 50.



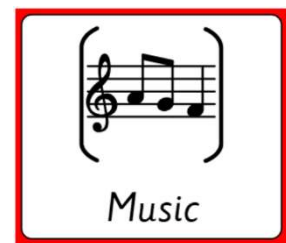
In topic we continued to explore our story, 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' and discussed the vocabulary (smallest, bigger and biggest). We also looked carefully at the story setting and focused on the river the three Billy Goats had to cross. We did this by watching and listening to the sounds of a river, before making a streamer to represent the water travelling down the river. We then used this knowledge to create and paint our own rivers, using a range of brushes and light/ dark blues and white paints.



In addition to exploring rivers, we returned to our learning from last week and built model bridges from recyclable materials. We thought carefully about structure and shape before using a range of techniques such as hinges, gluing, and combining materials to add strength. We then tested them to see if they were strong enough to allow the three billy goats to cross.



Finally, this week we enjoyed learning with Emily, our amazing music teacher! We continued to sing, clap, stomp and wave to a fast and slow rhythm. We then used percussion instruments to add to our performance. We had great fun!

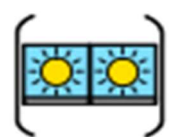
