



*This week we have finished reading, 'Monsters Don't Eat Broccoli', in our literacy sessions. We have used Colourful Semantics to write sentences and 'purple' descriptive words to describe a monster.*

*In Sensory Explore we've explored lots of different activities including vegetable printing, popcorn pictures, cooked pasta exploration, and spice painting.*

*In My Topic we explored crunchy and soft foods. Children predicted whether the food would crunch or be soft when it was either tasted or felt.*

*In Play and Leisure children used different building equipment to build towers and structures. They used a variety of items including wooden blocks and Lego.*

*This week in Outdoor School children made obstacle courses and mini see-saws, explored 'longer' and 'shorter', listened to the story 'Dinosaurs Love Underpants', used trowels to dig holes and made a 'broccoli soup' (with the broccoli that monsters don't eat!)*
