





This week we have finished reading, 'Monsters Don't Eat Broccoli', in our literacy sessions. We have used Colourful Semantics to write sentences and 'purple' descriptive words to describe a monster.

In Sensory Explore we've explored lots of different activities including vegetable printing, popcorn pictures, cooked pasta exploration, and spice painting.

In My Topic we explored crunchy and soft foods. Children predicted whether the food would crunch or be soft when it was either tasted or felt.

In Play and Leisure children used different building equipment to build towers and structures. They used a variety of items including wooden blocks and Lego.

This week in Outdoor School children made obstacle courses and mini see-saws, explored 'longer' and 'shorter', listened to the story 'Dinosaurs Love Underpants', used trowels to dig holes and made a 'broccoli soup' (with the broccoli that monsters don't eat!)
