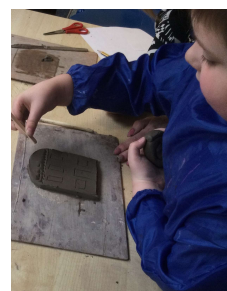
Topic
