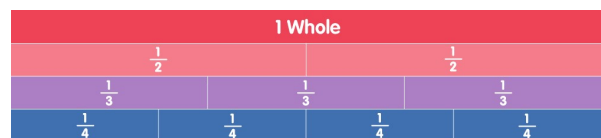

This week in Literacy we have been learning about cinquain poems. The children have learnt the features of a cinquain poem - 5 lines with a different rule for each line. We have been working on our noun, verb and adjective recognition and then identified synonyms.

Numeracy

We have continued our work on fractions in Numeracy this week. The children have been learning to recognise fractions when written in words and when written as a fraction, e.g. one half is $\frac{1}{2}$ and have used this learning to look at fractions of shapes.



Topic

We have completed our final lessons on our 'Bright Sparks' Topic this week. The children concluded their investigation on insulators and conductors by testing out each material within their circuit to see whether it allowed electricity to flow through it or not. They



then wrote up their method and conclusions on the investigation and compared their results to their predictions.
