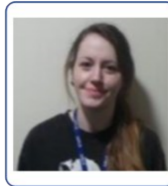
Welcome back!

Children have settled in really well in their first week back. The class staff have really enjoyed getting to know them all. I know we are going to have a fantastic year in Class 7!

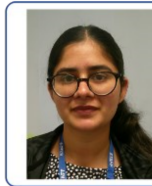

### Literacy

This week we read the story "Clean Up" by Nathan Byron. In this story, a little girl goes on holiday to the beach and cleans up all the plastic litter. We talked about what we like to do at the beach and then turned class 7 into our own beach and made sandcastles, explored the water and sea creatures, and made our own ice lollies with yoghurt and fruit. We also looked at sea turtles and the children used collage to create their own turtles. We then learned about things that are made from plastic and how we can stop plastic from ending up in the oceans by recycling and reusing. Children used junk modelling to make their own imaginative creations.



### Numeracy

The children enjoyed taking part in some beach-themed numeracy activities. They explored the sand to find Numicon and identify to the correct numbers, matched different representations of numbers, and counted sea creatures.
