## Swimming

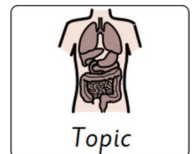
We had a fantastic first week at swimming! The children were all super sensible getting changed and in the pool. We're looking forward to the rest of our lessons and seeing the progress that the children make.

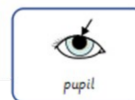
