

We all proved ourselves to be super scientists this week when we tested the hardness of different types of rocks. We used sandpaper, wood, plastic and metal to see what effect they would have on the rocks.

We found out that metamorphic rocks, such as slate and marble, were harder than other types of rock because our testing showed that these were the least damaged.
