Hello and welcome to another busy week at the Hub!




Haughton Hubs

In addition to this, the children have continued to identify 3D shapes by their properties. Investigating shapes that roll, and shapes that don't, before building a structure. The children used their knowledge of shape to find out what shapes were best for building and how the faces, vertices and overall shape added to their structures. 
