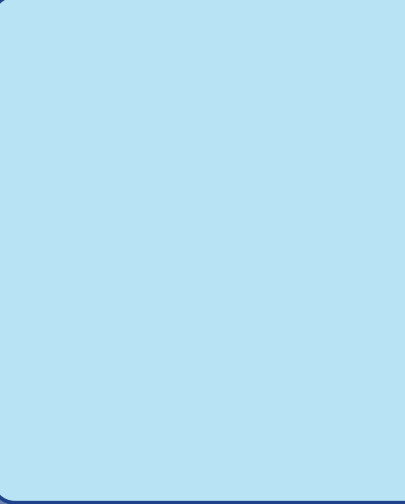
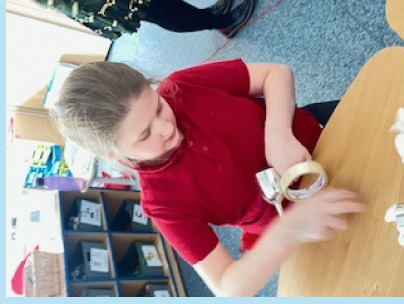
eggspersiment!
