Numeracy

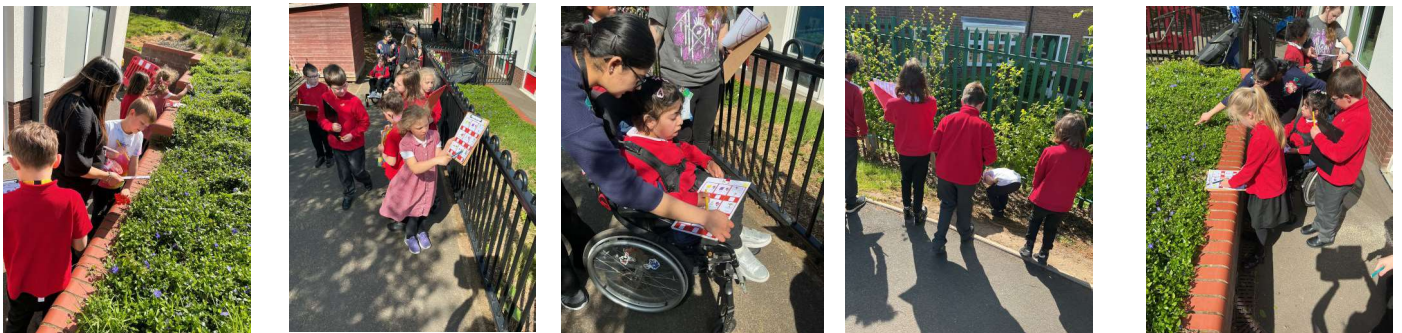
This week we have continued our work on Measure, focusing on Mass and Volume. Children have been learning to:

- Measure and compare mass using grams and kilograms
- Measure mass using cubes and balance scales
- Measure and compare capacity
