- ◆ Comparing mass

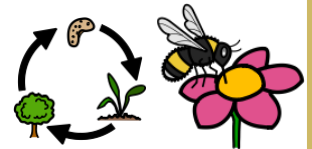


Some of us have continued working on fractions and have been:

## Topic

In topic we have been listening to the story 'The Tiny Seed' by Eric Carle and have been thinking about how a seed grows and changes over time. We have been sequencing images of a sunflower life cycle and identifying what happens at each stage - from a seed, to seedling and eventually to a full grown flower. We have also been listening to information about pollination. We had lots of fun using craft materials to make our own bees and also acted out how they move from flower to flower, helping plants grow.
