

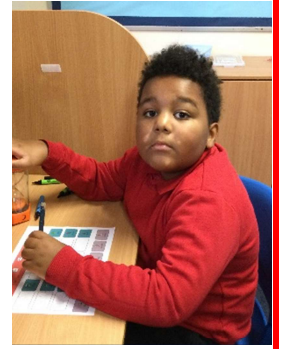
Literacy

In Literacy, the children have read to the end of 'The Snow Queen'. They have written a retell of the story. Some children have sequenced pictures to show the order of events whilst others have constructed sentences to match pictures using colourful semantics. The children have also written a book review and have discussed their favourite characters and events in the story.

In Storytime, the children have listened to 'Not Now, Bernard' by David McKee.



Numeracy

In Numeracy, the children have used the balance scales to weigh objects. They have compared the weight of different items using the terms heavier, lighter, greater than, less than and equal to. The children have used non-standard units to weigh a selection of fruits. Some children have been learning about 3D shapes. They have identified cubes and spheres and have completed a sorting activity.



PSHE

In PSHE, the children have continued to explore our topic: Healthy Me. They have been learning about things that are safe and unsafe. The children have looked at pictures showing potential hazards in a bathroom and a kitchen. They have discussed all the dangers and have shared ideas on how they could stay safe.

Topic

This week, the children have been learning about buildings that are unique and how they have been designed to suit their natural surroundings. The children have recreated some of these unique designs using cardboard boxes and junk modelling. In addition, they have matched photographs of buildings from around the world to their correct descriptions.
