




Hello and welcome to this week's news!

In Numeracy this week, we have revisited our knowledge of 2D shapes by recognising, naming and creating repeated patterns. Some of us then used this knowledge to explore 3D shapes in our environment. We noticed that the faces of 3D shapes are made up of 2D shapes











In literacy this week we have been reading and writing sentences about the story *The Gingerbread Man*. We have worked hard to use capital letters and full stops and to work with more independence.



In our topic 'Once Upon a time', we enjoyed reading a new story, *Little Red Riding Hood.*We enjoyed dressing up and using role-play to retell the story. We also thought carefully about the journey Little

Red Riding Hood took to get to Granma's house and used this knowledge to design a map with a key. We then used our designs to create a 3D map.









In computing the children have really enjoyed working with Miss Powell. They have been learning how to stay safe online and what to do if they feel unsafe. They have also explored a range of Art apps to support their learning and ICT skills. The children even spotted Street Art in their local community and asked to take a photo to show Miss Powell!









In R.E this week we explored the Easter story and how Christians celebrate Easter. We read the story and watched an artist retell the story, through Sand Art. We then used our own sand to represent our thinking.
