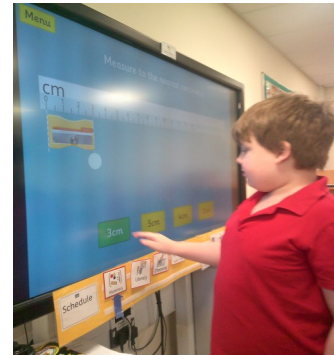
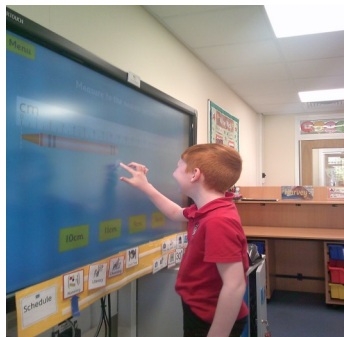
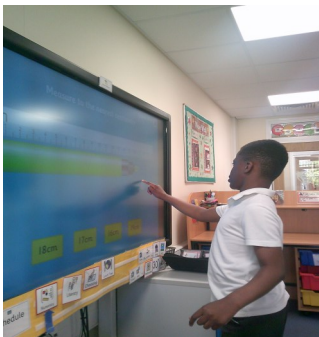
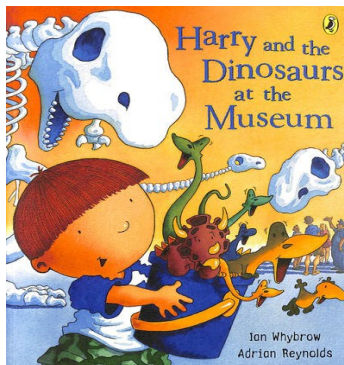
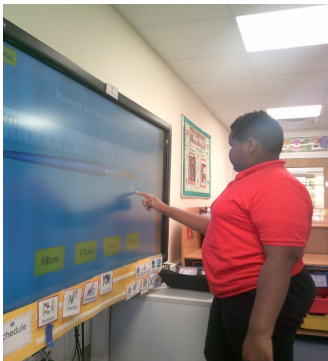
The children in Class 6 have had a fantastic week.
