
In Literacy, the children have enjoyed listening to the next chapter of 'The Hodgeheg' by Dick King-Smith. They have used colourful semantics to write sentences describing the animals living in the park. Some children have written sentences to describe the sights and sounds of traffic on a busy road. The children have listened carefully to a presentation on how to cross the road safely. They have ordered instructions and have practised crossing a road safely using the school playground.

Numeracy

In Numeracy, the children have continued to work on their multiplication skills and have completed number tracks counting in tens. Other children have been learning about fractions and have identified equal and unequal groups of objects as well as shapes that have been divided equally and unequally. Some children have been working hard to count, read and write numbers beyond 10.



PSHE

In PSHE, the children have continued to work within the topic: Relationships. They have listened to different scenarios involving conflict between friends and have thought carefully about how they could resolve friendship issues using the 'Mending Friendships Technique'. The children have shared ideas and have made suggestions about what they could do in each scenario.





Topic

The children have continued to enjoy our new topic: Freeze It. They have carried out an investigation to see how long it takes for an ice cube to melt. The children made predictions and carried out a fair test, recording the results at different stages of the experiment. The children also explored reversible change. They heated a bar of chocolate and made rice crispy cakes. The children made observations noting that once cooled, the chocolate changed back into a solid.



R.E

In R.E, the children have been learning about the traditional Jewish Shabbat dinner and have drawn pictures to show the challah bread and wine or grape juice. They have watched a video showing the lighting of a special candle to celebrate Havdalah, the ceremony that marks the end of Shabbat.
