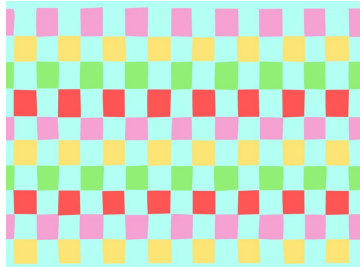

## Literacy

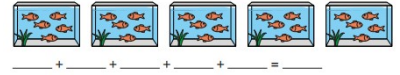

- ♦ Finding a quarter

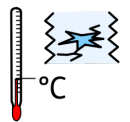
Some of us have been working on money and have been:
