

## News from the Hollinswood Hub: 23<sup>rd</sup> May 2025



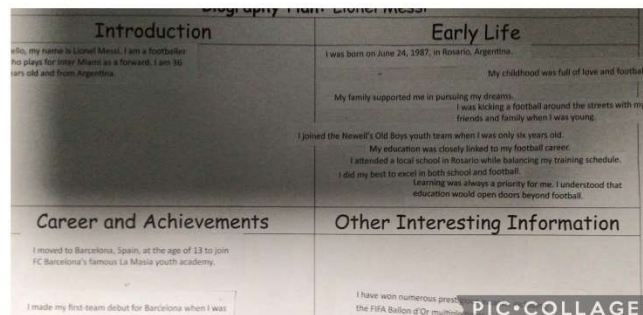
