#### **WREKIN FOREST SCHOOL TRIPS**

As part of their 'Stone Age' topic looking at scavengers and settlers, classes will be visiting Wrekin Forest School as below, to enjoy a day of outdoor fun!

Children will have the chance to experience lots of fun activities such as shelter building, looking at artefacts and learning about stone age housing, food and tools. If we have time during the day, children may be able to enjoy some of the other activities available, e.g. archery, assault course, trampoline, cooking, crafts, low ropes course, rope swing, pond dipping.

Children may get muddy so please send your child in to school in old joggers/tracksuit bottoms and trainers (although they must wear their usual Haughton School polo shirt/jumper please). Please also send a change of clothes in a carrier bag.

It is essential that your child has sunscreen applied before school and is provided with a cap/hat and a waterproof coat.

All children will need a packed lunch on their visit day. Please let us know if you would like a packed lunch to be ordered from the school kitchen or if you would prefer to send one in from home. (Children eligible for free school meals will not have to pay, all other packed lunches ordered will cost £2.90). School packed lunches include a choice of sandwich, a pot of salad, a piece of fruit, cheese & crackers, a pudding (e.g. a biscuit/cake) and a bottle of water.

We will be travelling by minibus, leaving school shortly after registration. We will return to school in time for usual transport home.

The cost of the visit including transport works out to £11.00 per child. *Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act 1988 there is no obligation to contribute and children will not be treated differently whether any contribution is made or not. However, the visit can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient.*

Can all payments please be made via your child's ParentPay account as soon as possible.
