



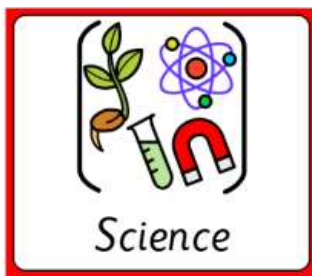
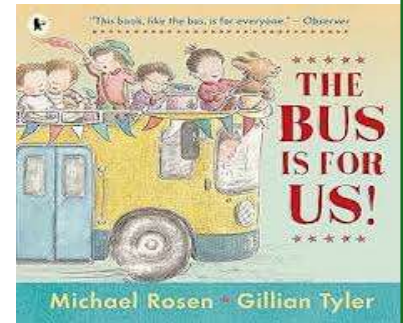

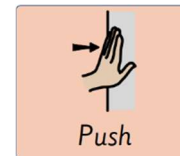

This week we have continued to explore our new topic 'Going Places'. We have been very excited to be learning more about our favourite types of transport and the way they travel. We have also enjoyed reading the story 'The Bus is for Us', as a shared read. It has been amazing to see the children's reading skills and confidence grow, as they read as a group. In science, we have used our knowledge of different types of vehicles to explore the action of pulling and pushing. First, we discussed the symbols and practiced the signs for push and pull and used this to support our communication and interaction.



We then used a range of vehicles to explore how each vehicle travelled on different surfaces.



We really enjoyed testing our vehicles using the ramps, grass and sand and we wanted to learn more. We then created our own model cars out of recycled materials and thought carefully how to make the wheels turn. Leo noticed the axle on his toy and used this as a model to make his own car, before testing his model car outside.





In Music this week, we have enjoyed singing and using percussion instruments to follow the rhythm and beat to Taylor Swift's 'Shake it off'.

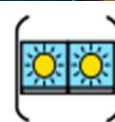
