

This week we have been working hard in all areas of our learning! Well Done, Guys! In literacy, the children have enjoyed reading a new story called 'Mr. Gumpy's Motor Car'. They then used toy cars and different animals to role-play the story and discussed why they thought Mr. Gumpy's car got stuck in the mud, but more importantly, how the children and animals helped to get Mr. Gumpy's car moving again.

In Topic, the children re-read the story and thought carefully about why Mr. Gumpy's car got stuck. As a result of this, we decided to carry out an experiment, to find out how

to change the consistency of mud. We then linked this learning to the story, and discussed what happened to the ground under Mr. Gumpy's car, when it started to rain?

















The children then used a range of vehicles to explore how each vehicle travelled on different surfaces and shared their thinking with the adults, before finally using the outside loose parts to build their favourite vehicles.







In Music this week, the children excitedly welcomed Emily for their weekly lesson. The children enjoyed singing and signing to the Hello and Goodbye songs and enjoyed playing their percussion instruments in time to the music and together. AMAZING WORK!!!


