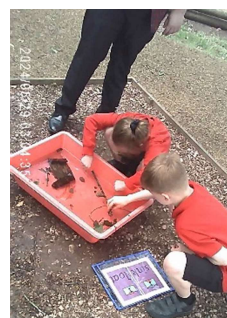


We have had a busy week in class 9 this week. In my topic we have been exploring where food comes from and where we can buy our food from. The children had fun making honey playdough and learning how bees make honey. We looked at how bread is made and what food is sold at a bakery. The children also had lots of fun playing with the supermarket role play.

In my outdoor learning we explored 'sinking and floating', the children explored the forest area and found sticks, flowers, stones, fir cones and feathers and recorded whether they would float or sink.

In my cooking the children made banana and strawberry smoothies, they used the blender to make these and enjoyed drinking their smoothies after the lesson.

In Numeracy we have continued with our focus on place value, some children have been matching numerals to the written words, while others have been estimating numbers on a number line to 50.
