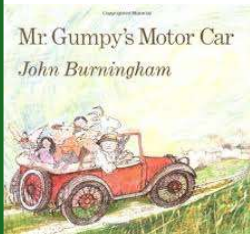

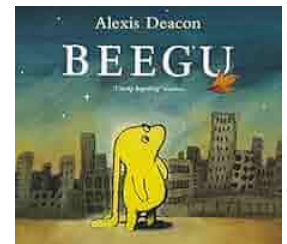

Hello and welcome to more news from the hub!



In literacy this week, we shared the story Mr Gumpy's Motor Car and created sentences about the different types of animals sitting in his car, before starting our new book Beegu.

Beegu is a delightful story about an alien who is separated from her parents and feels lost in an unfamiliar world. The children shared lots of thoughtful and caring ideas of how Beegu would have felt when she could not find her parents. In addition to this, the children have been amazing at sharing their own ideas and listening to their peers. Well done, Guys!



In Numeracy this week, some children have been exploring repeated addition and counting in 2s, while others have been exploring measure, using centimetres and then metres.



In music, the children took their learning outside to sign, sing and play their instruments in the sunshine.



Leo also joined his link class for music and his orchestra session. He enjoyed dancing and playing instruments with his peers.



In DT, the children have enjoyed re-reading our class story Beegu, and wondered how Beegu landed on Earth, but more importantly how could we help her return to her home planet. The children discussed what type of vehicle they would use to travel to space and used loose parts to construct a large rocket /spaceship together. They then used this knowledge to create their own individual model rockets. The children worked collaboratively to choose appropriate tools to cut and shape different materials.



While exploring space, Leo became an astronaut and had an amazing afternoon as he travelled the universe looking for Beegu's parents.
