This week, we have been enjoying the sunshine, working hard and getting ready for the next steps in our learning journeys.

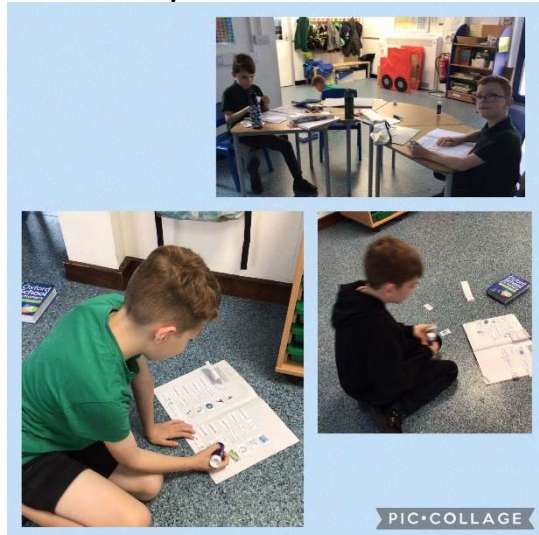

Firstly, we need to say a huge congratulations to Jake and George who have both completely smashed their SATS! Well done, boys. We are so proud of you both.

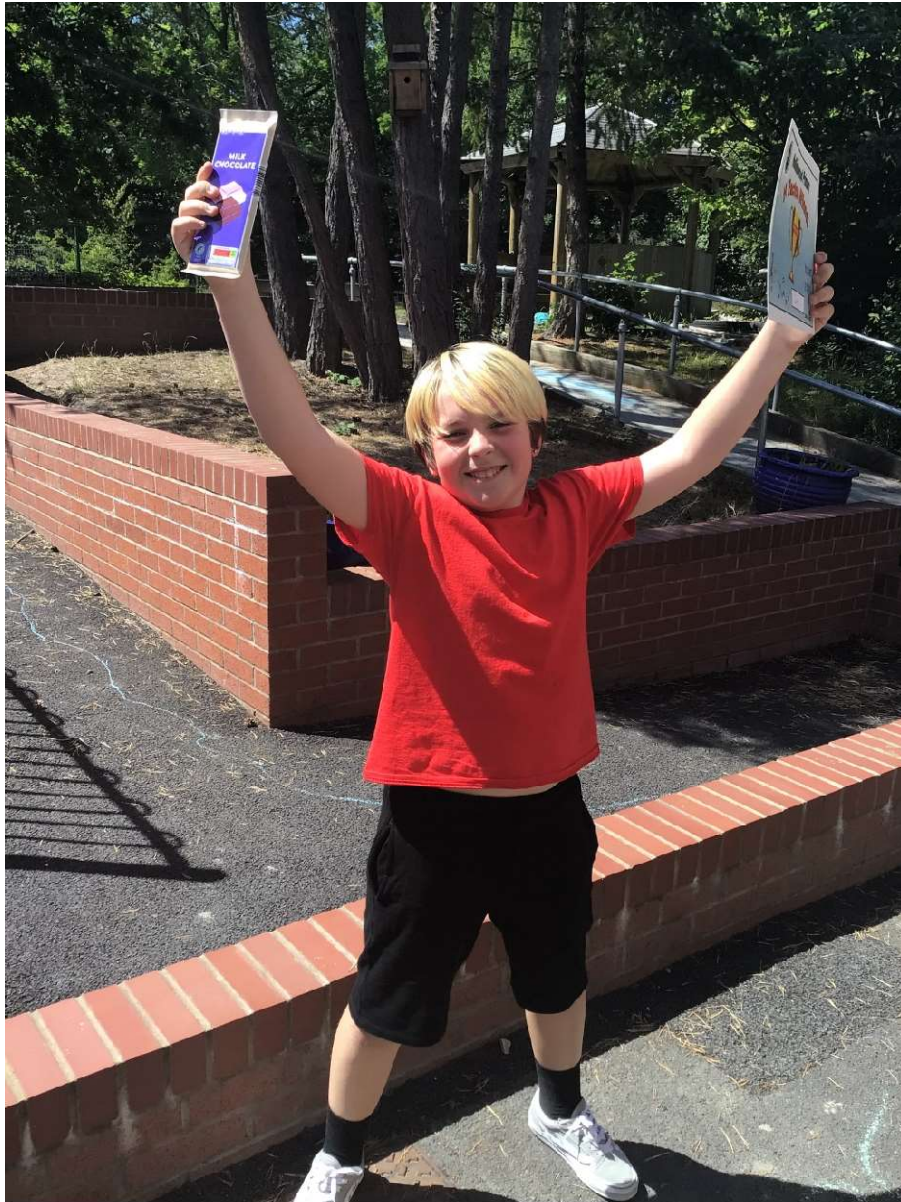
