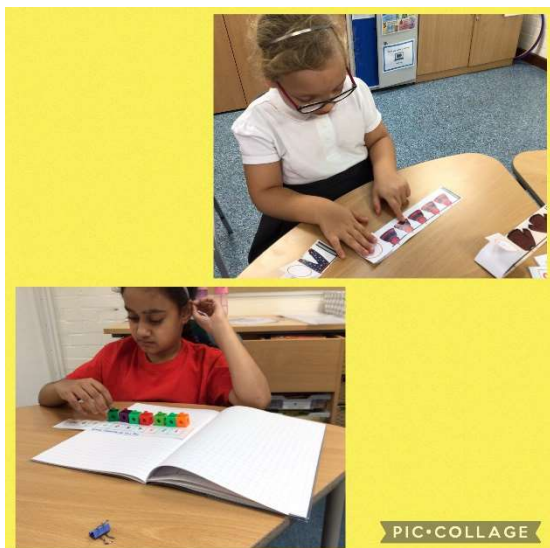




News from the Hollinswood Hub: 19th September 2025

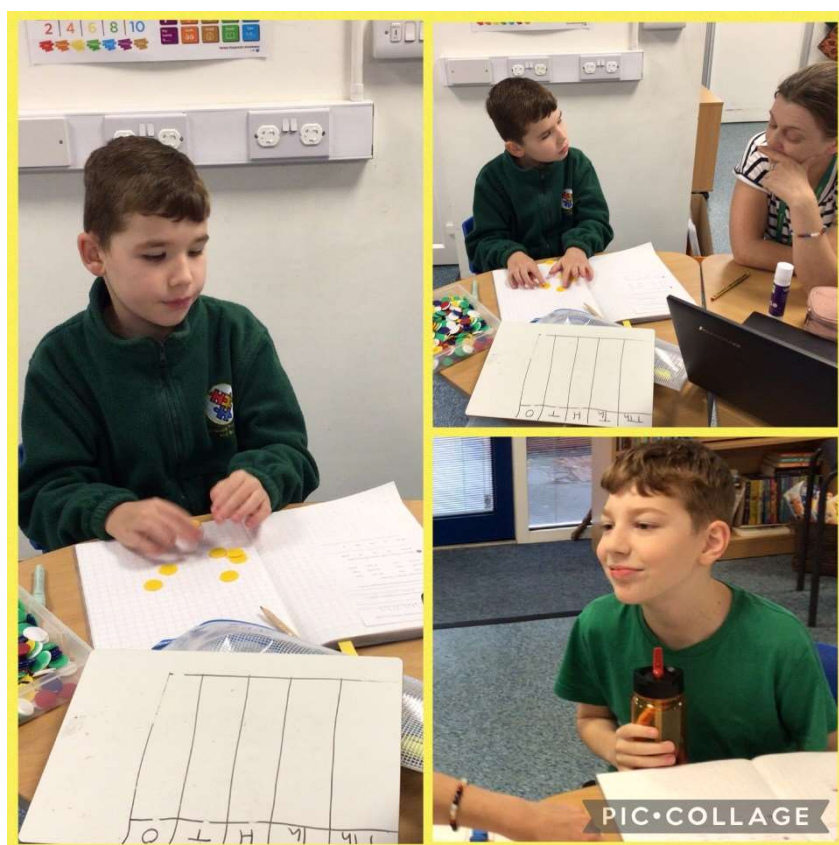
Hello and welcome back to another week of news from the Hollinswood hub. As always, everyone has been working really hard this week.
