

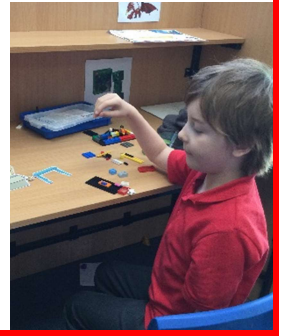

Class 4

Literacy

In Literacy, the children have listened to the next chapter of 'Beauty and the Beast'. They enjoyed watching a clip from the Disney film and used colourful semantics to describe the Dungeon. The children used their phonic knowledge to identify initial sounds and labelled a picture of Cogsworth. In addition, they used colourful semantics to construct simple sentences to describe his character.

In Storytime, the children listened to 'Oi Frog!' by Kes Gray and Jim Field.



Numeracy

This week in Numeracy, the children have continued to develop their understanding of place value. They have used counters and the ten frames to represent a given number of objects. In addition, the children have practised recognising numbers as words. Some children have used the place value chart to identify two-digit numbers and have used base 10 to represent a given number.



PSHE

In PSHE, the children have continued to work on our jigsaw puzzle piece: Being Me in My World. They have thought carefully about rewards and consequences and what is fair. The children have listened carefully to different classroom scenarios and have decided whether the pupils deserve a reward or a consequence. In addition, they have completed a giant star to show all their favourite rewards.



Topic

The children have continued to enjoy our topic, 'People of the Past'. This week, they have been learning about the Austrian composer, Mozart. They have answered questions about his life and listened carefully to music composed by Mozart. The children enjoyed making musical instruments out of junk modelling and played their instruments following their own rhythm grids.
