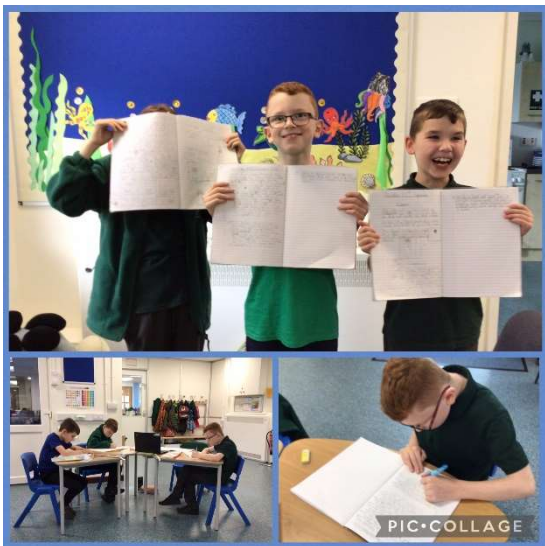




News from the Hollinswood Hub: 3rd October 2025

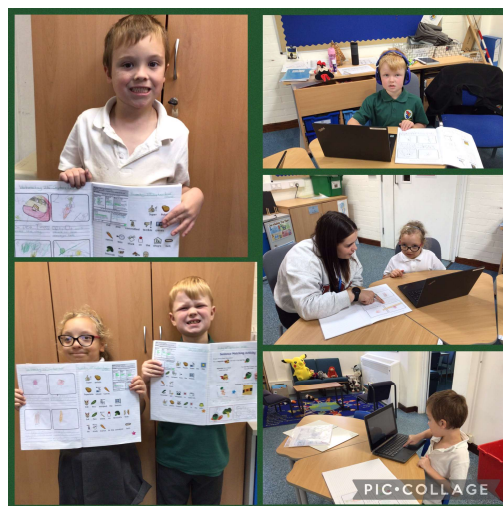
Hello and welcome back to another week of news from the Hollinswood hub.
