Class 4

Literacy

In Literacy, the children have continued to enjoy our class story, 'Beauty and the Beast.' This week, they have written an invitation to Belle, inviting her to attend a special dinner. The children used word mats to help with their writing and tried hard to include all the important information. In addition, the children have written a thank you letter from Belle. They used colourful semantics to support their writing and enjoyed reading their letters at the end of the lesson.



During Storytime, the children listened to 'The Perfect Fit' by Naomi and James Jones.

Numeracy

In Numeracy, the children have continued to explore number bonds within 10. They have used the ten frame and concrete apparatus to calculate number bonds to 6, 7, 8 and 9. The children have then applied these skills to solve simple word problems. Some children have worked hard to add three single-digit numbers. They have used their knowledge of bonds to 10 to help them with their calculations as well as pictorial representations and a number line.



Topic

The children have continued to enjoy our new topic: What's It Made Of? This week they have been learning about plastic and how it is made. The children began by identifying a variety of objects made from plastic, then carried out an investigation to explore the characteristics of this material. The children talked about the damaging effects that plastic can have on the environment and the importance of recycling this material safely.



PSHE

The children have continued their work on our Jigsaw topic 'Celebrating Difference.' This week, our focus has been on understanding bullying and what they should do if they, or someone they know is being bullied. The children shared ideas and discussed the importance of getting help and support by talking to a trusted adult about what is happening. The children completed a group activity and enjoyed creating an anti-bullying poster.
