

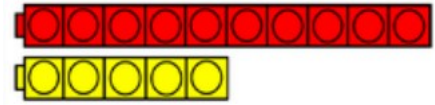

This week we have continued to work on our Addition and Subtraction skills through a range of practical activities. Children have been learning to:

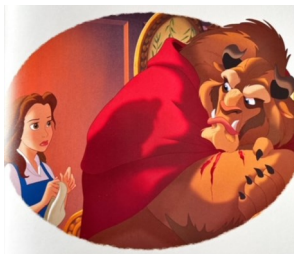
- Understand related facts such as $2+3=5$ and $20+30=50$

The difference between 10 and 5 is

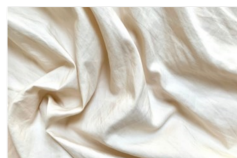
Literacy

This week in Literacy, we continued reading *Beauty and the Beast*. In the story, Belle explored the forbidden West Wing of the castle, and the children retold what happened using 'who', 'doing', 'what', and 'where' words. The Beast then saved Belle from wolves in the forest, so we talked about how Belle could say thank you by helping him. Children wrote down their choices for how Belle should help, such as looking after his wounds or cleaning the castle. We have also worked on using capital letters for names of characters this week.



Topic

This week, in our topic 'What's it Made Of?' we learned about fabric. Children investigated the properties of fabric and explored if they could squash it, bend it, see through it, and soak up water with it. Then we looked at a range of objects and the children sorted them into groups of 'fabric' or 'not fabric'. We also learned about where cotton comes from and how it is made into the clothes we wear.



Swimming

Class 7 had their final swimming lesson this week, where we enjoyed a fun session with floats, balls, and toys. All the children have really enjoyed going swimming. Some children have progressed to swimming without flotation aids and others have grown in confidence with entering the pool and going underwater.
