Literacy

In Literacy this week, the children listened to the final chapter of *Beauty and the Beast*. They described what happened in the story using picture cues and who, doing what words to write simple sentences and captions. The children thoroughly enjoyed watching the animated Disney film of *Beauty and the Beast*.

During Storytime, the children listened to 'All Right All Ready. A Snowy Story' by Jory John and Benjie Davies.



Numeracy

In Numeracy, the children have continued to enjoy our topic on shape. They have enjoyed exploring the properties of 3D shapes, recognising the 2D shapes that appear on their faces, and working hard to count the number of edges and vertices each shape has. Some children have continued to focus on developing their understanding of 2D shapes, practising naming them and describing their key features.



Topic

This week, the children have enjoyed taking part in a fun materials quiz. They listened carefully to words describing different materials and had to decide whether the material was wood, metal, plastic or fabric. The children explored a range of objects around school and worked together to identify which materials they are made from.



PSHE

The children have continued to think about why it is important not to make assumptions based on how someone looks. Working with a partner, they tried to guess each other's favourite colour, TV programme, school lesson, animal, and food. They then compared their guesses with their partners actual choices and discovered that our assumptions are often wrong.
