

We've had another wonderful week in class. Our story focus has continued with *The Crunching Munching Caterpillar*, and the children have been busy creating their own caterpillar fact files. They explored what caterpillars like to eat, where they live, and whether they have wings.

In numeracy, we've begun our new topic on place value. Some children have been practising subitising numbers 1–5, while others have been working on counting on from a given number up to 10.

Our topic work has taken us into the world of plants. We talked about what plants need to grow well and recapped what the children already knew. We also planted cress seeds, some with water and some without to investigate which ones will grow and why.

It's been a busy and exciting week of learning. We're looking forward to seeing how our cress experiment turns out next week!
