

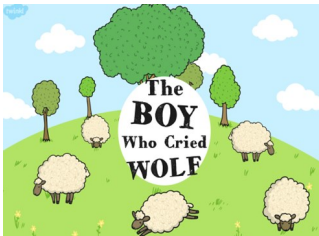

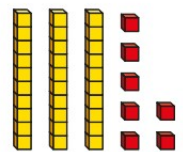

- ◆ Estimating numbers on a number line

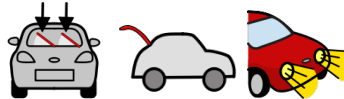


Some of us have continued working on multiplication and division and have been:

- ◆ Answering related calculations

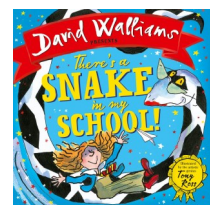
Topic
