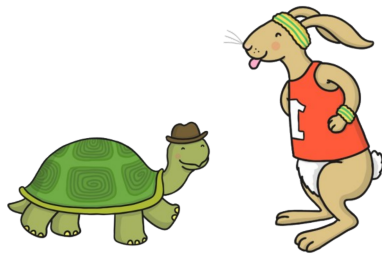

Literacy

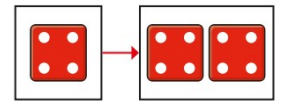
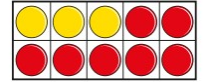

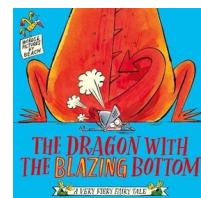
Topic
