


# Class 12!

In Literacy this week we had our final lesson on Stitch's Valentine where the children decided on their favourite character and explained why either verbally or written.

Most of the children decided on Angel as she was 'tiny' and 'cute'. We are now looking at Ironman where the children have had a brief look at a video from Ironman and used different adjectives explaining Ironman's appearance.



In Numeracy this week we have been looking more in detail at shape, in particular 'patterns between 2d and 3d shapes', 'sorting 2d shapes into groups' and 'measuring and drawing accurately using a ruler'. The children have shown great persistence to persevere through difficult questions.

Through Class 12's Topic lessons we have been learning about 'Feel the force' looking at magnets, friction, gravity etc. Children this week have been looking at our new word 'Buoyancy'. We have been learning about this through different practical activities. We made a prediction on which items would sink or float in a bowl of water, this helped the children understand the weight of the water's upthrust was heavier than the object allowing some items to float. Next, we will be looking at different shapes and how these impact Buoyancy.

The Children have really enjoyed their music block and have blown away the teacher. She was so impressed with our ability to compose our own sounds and play them at the same time as another group.

We were so proud of our children on Tuesday morning where we attended St Michaels Church. The children walked beautifully and sensibly there and back, listening to instructions and always holding hands with their partners when asked to. The children asked some amazing questions to the Church staff and listened to a lovely story which they all did super listening!
