As part of sensory explore each morning the children have really enjoyed exploring slurpy, foam and glitter, playdoh and colouring.

On Monday we joined Class 11 for My Well-being outside on the MUGA. We played parachute games together as well as playing with balls and bubbles. The children really enjoyed themselves.

On Tuesday, in music, children explored different sounds that could be made with a drum. They then performed a short song - 'It's raining, it's pouring...', to emphasise the different sounds. On Friday the children repeated the activity as a whole class, rather than the smaller groups, from earlier in the week. It was lovely to see and hear the children perform and remember what they had practiced earlier in the week.

In cooking we made banana flapjack. The children enjoyed eating it at Outdoor School on Thursday. Whilst there they also hunted for teddies, jumped in puddles, made love heart nature pictures and explored the slippery, muddy path but had lots of fun doing so and many quite pleased with themselves when they got to the end!
