
Here at the hub, we also like to keep our bodies healthy by keeping fit and active. We had a great PE session this week; developing our co-ordination, balance and agility skills.

Everyone did really well and had lots of fun learning new skills.




In Geography, we have been learning about the rivers in the UK. We used maps to locate the rivers then created posters to show what we had learnt.


We had a great morning reading books and enjoying our favourite stories.
