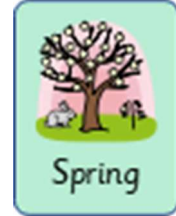

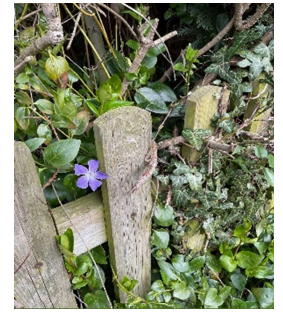
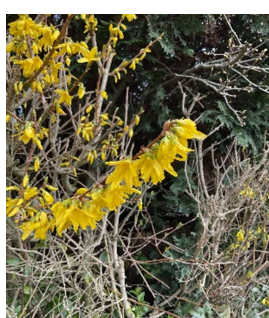
Welcome

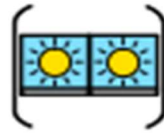
