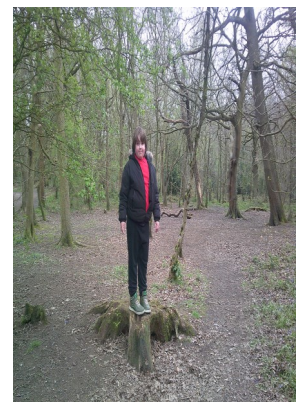
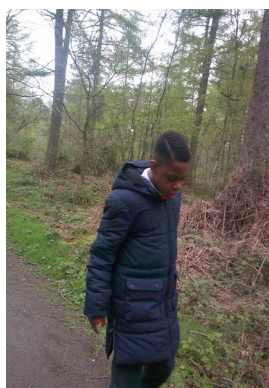
The children in class 6 have had a fantastic week.
