In Literacy the children have been listening to a story all about the different processes that take place on the farm from plough-

ing the field, planting the seeds, watering the crop, bringing in the vegetables and then cooking and eating them. This ties in with our topic work this term where we will be planting seeds and looking after a selection of flowers and vegetables.



In numeracy the children have been exploring long and short. They really

enjoyed our practical lesson where they drew a long and a short line in chalk on the floor and then filled the line with mathematical equipment such as beads, teddies, animals and cars. They also sequenced some worms by their length and created their own long and short worms with playdoh.



The children have also been busy with their independent writing activity where they have written about a picture and what they have seen within it.
