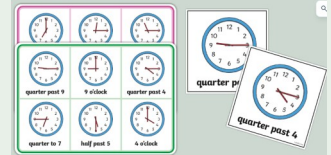


Newsletter 1st May 2026 Class 3

This week in Literacy the children have continued to read a book called 'The Tractor' and have completed several activities linked to this. They were able to create their own tractor when given the correct picture parts and they were also labelled a tractor. Some children needed help to read the words and other children were able to complete this task independently.



In Numeracy we have started to work on 'Time'. The children have enjoyed lots of interactive games on the Ipad, as well as playing bingo games and exploring our own clocks to set the time from a model, a verbal or written request.



Our seeds we planted last week are started to sprout and the children have been busy talking to them to encourage them to grow and also making sure that they get plenty of water and sunlight. In our topic lesson we continued with the theme of seeds and have explored a variety of fruits that contain seeds, this included melon, tomatoes and plums.
