Literacy

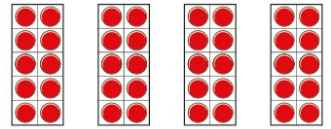

Numeracy

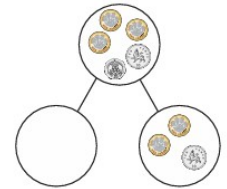
In Numeracy some of us have been working on multiplication and division. We have been:
