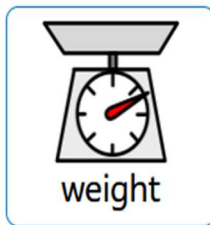


Maths

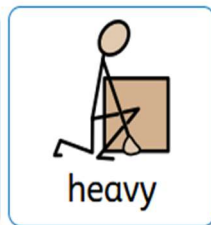

While the Yr2 children recapped how to use a set of scales before beginning to record their results in grams. Some children also decided to become human scales.



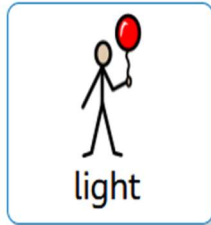

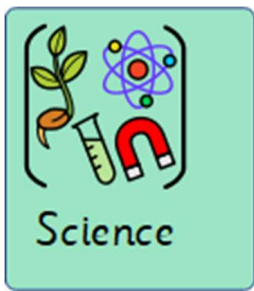


Literacy



Phonics

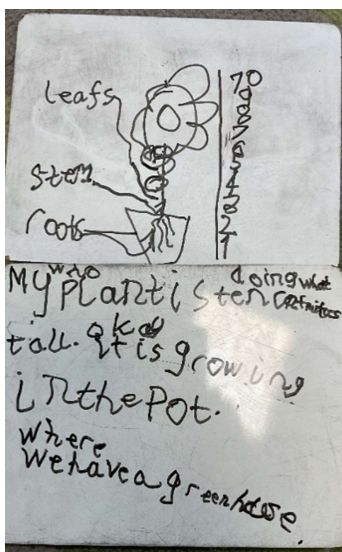
In literacy, we have been using our phonic knowledge, punctuation skills and time conjunctions to write a set of instructions, on how to plant a sunflower seed.

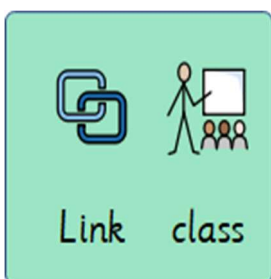


This week, we have continued to add to our scientific knowledge linked to plants and how they grow. The children have explored a range of different plants and used key terms to identify and name a variety of garden and wild plants. They have also continued to learn about the life cycle of a sunflower, by observing their own sunflower seeds, planted last week. Together, we recorded our findings in a sunflower diary, and we can already see signs of growth!!!! We have also planted and added onions, cucumbers and peppers to our hub garden.



We were very excited this week, as we were kindly gifted a small greenhouse from the Hollinswood gardening club! Together, we rebuilt the greenhouse ready for both KS1 and KS2 children to use in the hub garden. We made sure it was anchored down, so it would not blow away in the wind and carefully placed it in an appropriate position outside.



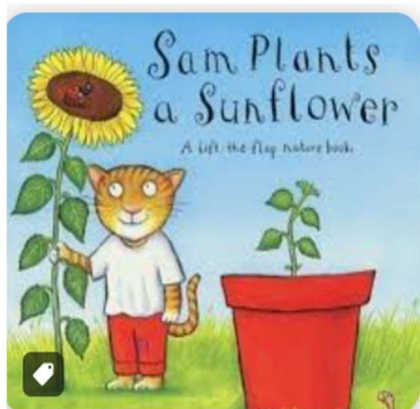

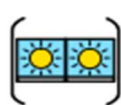
