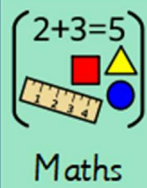
Welcome

Hello and welcome to more news from the Hub!

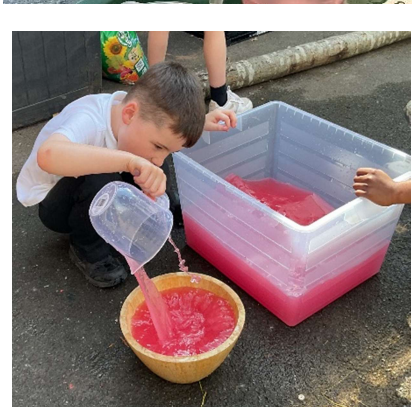
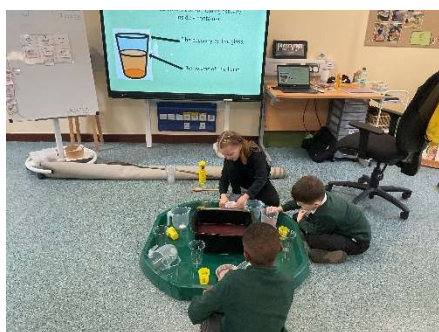
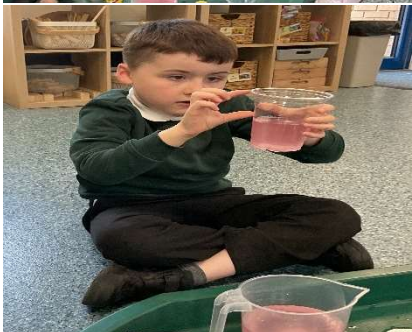
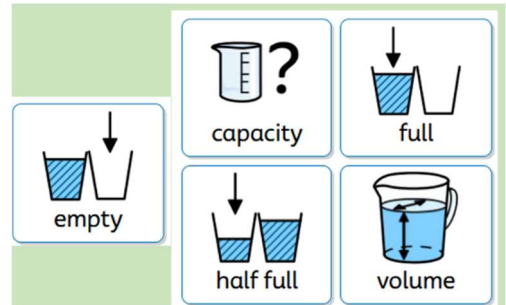
This week the children have continued to work hard and enjoy their learning, both inside and outside of the classroom.

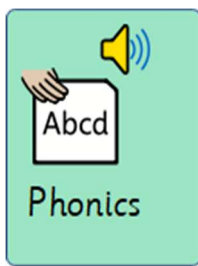

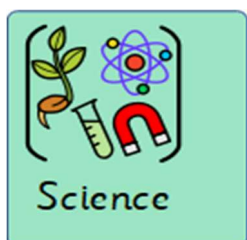
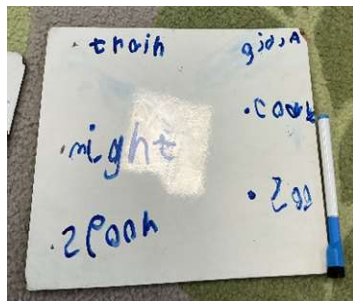
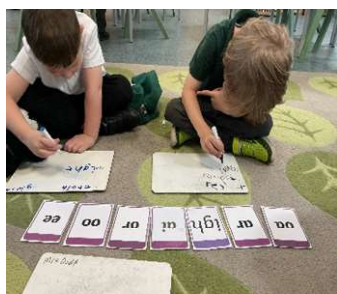


In maths, the children have been using a range of resources to explore capacity and volume. They have started to compare, describe and use key vocabulary to support their learning. Some children have been measuring and recording their results by using the unit measure of millilitres.





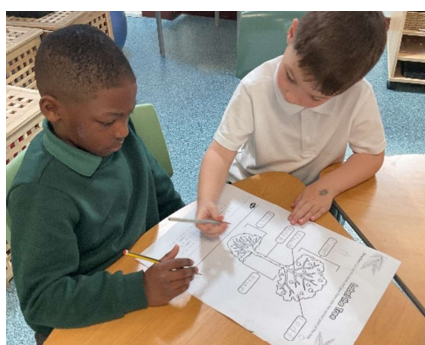
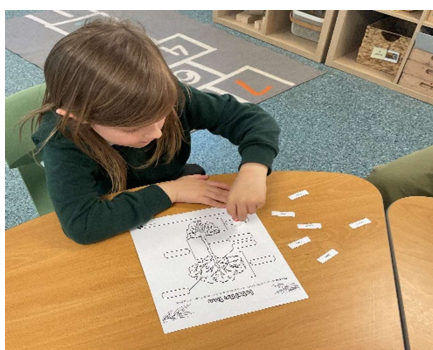
In Phonics and literacy, we have been consolidating previously taught sounds and working hard to orally blend and segment these within new words. We are now seeing amazing progress in all our reading and writing. Well done all!



In Science, the children have continued to work scientifically and make observations over time. They have watered their sunflower seedlings daily and then measured and recorded the growth each week.



They have also added to their knowledge of plants and how they grow, by discussing and labelling the parts of a tree. The children have thought carefully about why trees are so important to the wonderful world around us and how we can look after them.

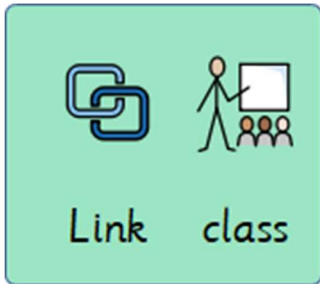


They then took their learning outside to identify, feel and describe the structure of living trees in the hub garden.



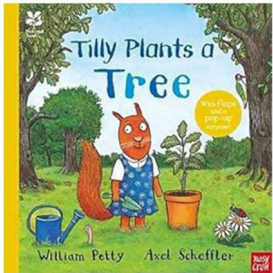

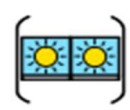
